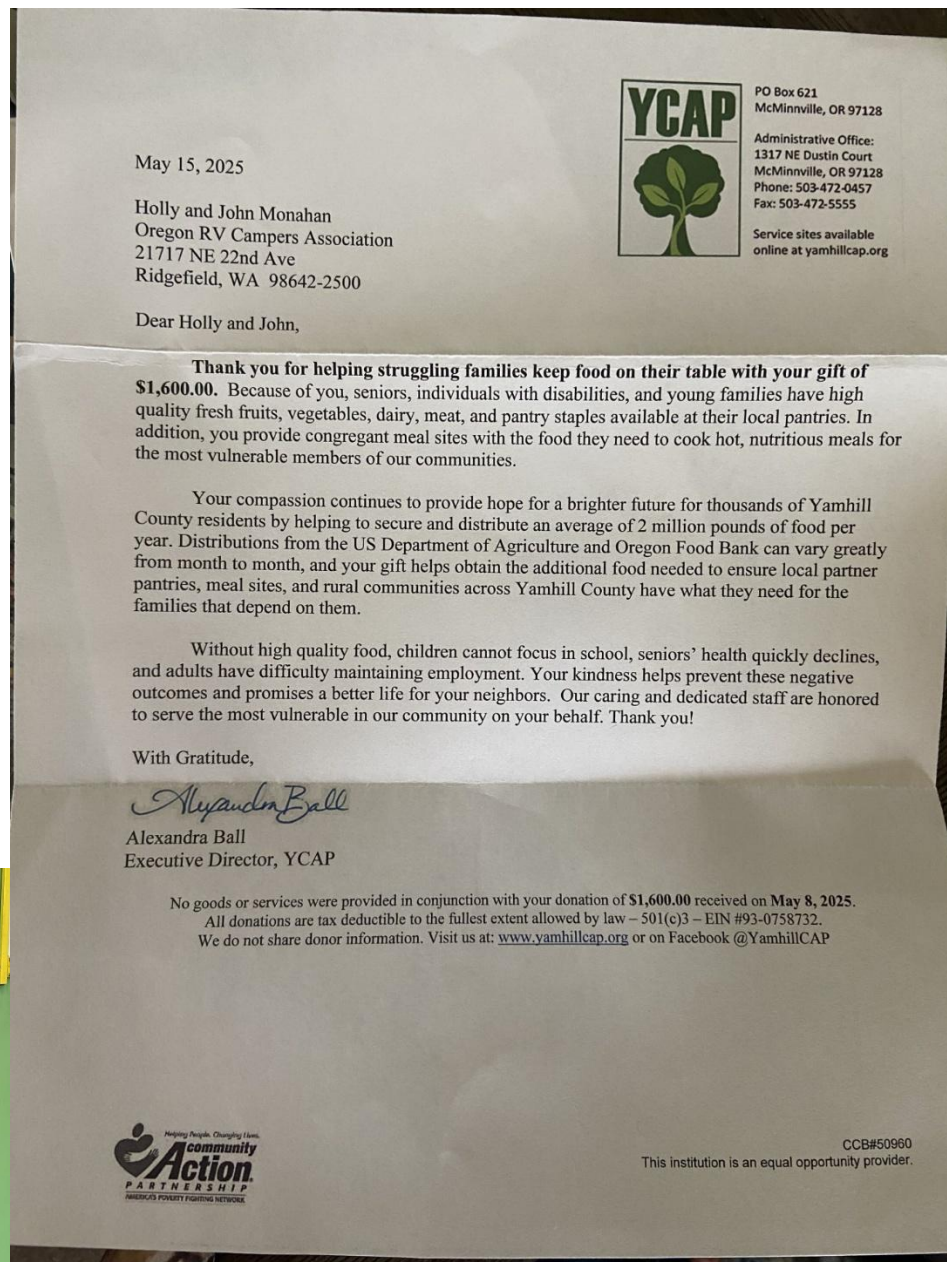
ORCA Auction at Olde Stone RV Resort

But where did the proceeds from our auction go?

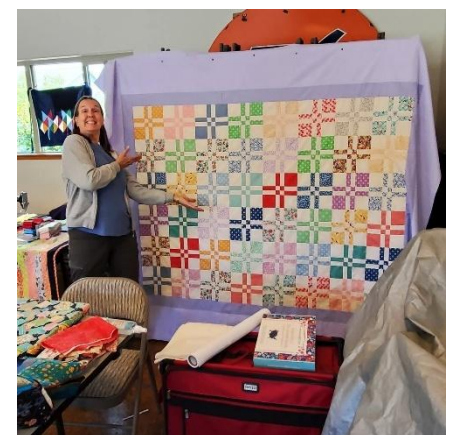

MARION GILKEY'S PEA 'N' PEANUT SALAD

Many of you have asked for Marion's pea salad recipe that she brings to rally. It is such a big hit and we're lucky that she's willing to share. Here it is!

Ingredients:

1 package (10 ounces) frozen peas
1 cup dry roasted peanuts
1 cup chopped celery
6 bacon strips, cooked and crumbled
¼ cup chopped red onion
½ cup mayonnaise
¼ cup prepared zesty Italian salad dressing

Directions:

In a large bowl, combine the peas, peanuts, celery, bacon, and onion. In a small bowl, combine the mayonnaise and Italian dressing. Pour over salad and toss to coat. Chill until serving. **YIELD:** 5 servings

NOTE: Marion omits the Italian dressing from this recipe, and just coats the salad with mayonnaise. It's her personal preference. 😊

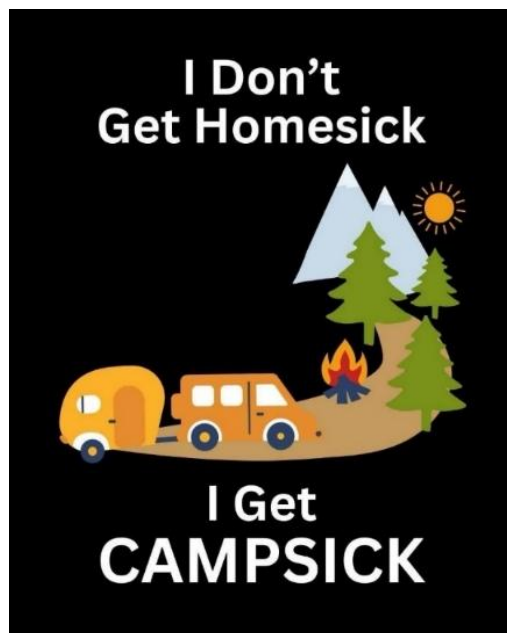

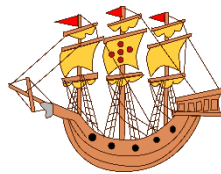
