ORCA Auction at Olde Stone RV Resort


Thanks to all who participated in the auction, we raised \$1600!!!

MARION GILKEY'S PEA 'N' PEANUT SALAD

Many of you have asked for Marion's pea salad recipe that she brings to rally. It is such a big hit and we're lucky that she's willing to share. Here it is!

Ingredients:

- 1 package (10 ounces) frozen peas
- 1 cup dry roasted peanuts
- 1 cup chopped celery
- 6 bacon strips, cooked and crumbled
- ¼ cup chopped red onion
- ½ cup mayonnaise
- 1/4 cup prepared zesty Italian salad dressing

Directions:

In a large bowl, combine the peas, peanuts, celery, bacon, and onion. In a small bowl, combine the mayonnaise and Italian dressing. Pour over salad and toss to coat. Chill until serving. **YIELD:** 5 servings

NOTE: Marion omits the Italian dressing from this recipe, and just coats the salad with mayonnaise. It's her personal preferrence.


