














# **2025 POW WOW**

Where: Hood River Fairgrounds, Odell, Oregon

When: August 22 through the morning of August 24.

**Directions**: Interstate 84 to Hood River Exit 64, South to Hwy 35 to Odell cut off, turn right through town, follow the road to the left then right, then left following the road signs to the fairgrounds.

**Cost:** \$35.00 per person for Friday and Saturday night which includes water, electricity (use a surge protector to protect your RV) and use of the dump station upon **departure.** 

The Meal fee entitles you to Thursday Early Bird Surprise Dessert, three breakfasts, and two dinners. Day passes for those not camping on the fairgrounds are \$5.00 per person, per day and does not include meals.
